**REGARDING: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MODIFICATIONS TO PARKING OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT AGREEMENTS (COLLECTIVELY, “RAMP AGREEMENTS”) AT: (I) ROBERT STREET MUNICIPAL RAMP AT 95 E. 7TH STREET, (II) LOWERTOWN MUNICIPAL RAMP AT 316 JACKSON STREET, (III) LAWSON MUNICIPAL RAMP AT 10 W. 6TH STREET, (IV) SMITH TRANSIT CENTER RAMP AT 145 SMITH AVE., AND (V) KELLOGG MUNICIPAL RAMP AT 129 KELLOGG BOULEVARD, DISTRICT 17, WARD 2**

**Requested Board Action**

Approve and authorize staff to execute and complete 5 parking ramp agreement extension amendments.

**Background**

The HRA owns five parking ramps, which are operated by certain operators named in the Ramp Agreements, and each of the five Ramp Agreements are scheduled to expire on December 31, 2022. Staff recommends modifications to the Ramp Agreements to extend the term of each of the parking and operating agreements for the five municipal ramps until such time as the HRA can issue requests for proposal for new operating agreements. Recommended extension dates are as follows:

- Lawson Ramp: extend to 12/31/2023
- Lowertown Ramp: extend to 12/31/2023
- Robert St. Ramp: extend to 12/31/2024
- Kellogg Ramp: extend to 12/31/2026
- Smith Ramp: extend to 12/31/2026
