The area of origin was the ceiling. The first fuel/material ignited was most likely an overloaded electrical wire. The ignition source was most likely paper and cellulose. The oxidant was normal atmospheric air. The action that brought these items together was overheating of electrical wires. The classification of fire cause is accidental. This concludes my investigation and report.
