Dear Ms. Larsen;

I am pleased to inform you that you are approved for a two year Byrne Justice Assistance Criminal and Juvenile Justice Intervention Renewal grant for the Neighborhood Justice Program. With these unprecedented times we understand that programming and spending got interrupted in this last year and we are happy to continue to support the work that you are doing with your current JAG grant.

To go along with the unprecedented times, the structure of this renewal grant will be a little out of the ordinary. The plan for the renewal grant is that we will end the current grant at its current end date with no amendments to extend it. The new grant will have a grant period of October 1, 2021-September 30, 2023 and any remaining funds from the current grant will be added to a new award amount of \$192,000 to complete a grant award for the next two years. The new award amount was based on current average spending levels.

I will follow up with more details in the upcoming weeks for what is needed for the renewal grant application in e-grants.
