Re: Stay of enforcement for the Removal or Repair of the Structure at 587 Cook Avenue East

Dear Gerald Krippner:

This is to confirm that, per your request, this matter was laid over from Legislative Hearing on August 9 to Tuesday, August 23, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. in room 330 City Hall.

At that time it is expected that you or any potential purchaser will have the following items submitted and/or completed and ready for Council approval on August 24:

- 1) A signed purchase agreement indicating <u>title won't transfer until the rehabilitation is</u> <u>complete and nuisance abated;</u>
- 2) A \$5,000 Performance Deposit posted with the Department of Safety & inspections;
- 3) **submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation.** Staff estimates costs to exceed \$75,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case by case basis;
- 4) **submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project** and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued;
- 5) **submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work.** This should include **signed** subcontractor bids and a **schedule** for completion of the project; and
- 6) The property will continue to be maintained

This matter will again go before the City Council for Public Hearing on Wednesday, August 24, 2022 at 3:30 p.m. in room 300 City Hall. If will be contesting Ms. Moermond's recommendation from the August 23 hearing you may appear in person or send written



testimony to be added to the record to <a href="legislativehearings@ci.stpaul.mn.us">legislativehearings@ci.stpaul.mn.us</a> or by voicemail at 651-266-6805. Should you wish to address Council directly but not appear in person, you must register in person by noon on Tuesday, August 23 here:
