## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE ADOPTION OF A TAX INCREMENT FINANCING PLAN FOR FARWELL YARDS TAX INCREMENT FINANCING DISTRICT (A REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota (the "City") will meet on Wednesday, September 14, 2022 at 3:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at the City Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 15 West Kellogg Boulevard, Saint Paul, Minnesota, for the purpose of conducting a public hearing on the proposal of the Housing and Redevelopment Authority of the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota (the "HRA") to (i) establish the Farwell Yards Tax Increment Financing District (a redevelopment district) (the "TIF District") in the Saint Paul Riverfront Redevelopment Project Area (the "Project Area"), and (ii) approve a Tax Increment Financing Plan therefor (the "TIF Plan").

A map is set forth below indicating the boundaries of the TIF District and the boundaries of the Project Area, where the increments may be collected and expended, respectively, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 469.174 through 469.1794.

At the time and place fixed for the Public Hearing, the City Council will give all persons who appear at the hearing an opportunity to express their views with respect to the proposed establishment of the TIF District and adoption of the TIF Plan therefor.
