This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on December 21, 2021, Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond recommended that the City Council grant your appeal for Unit 2 to be released from the Vacant Building program. Unit 1 to be made a Category 1 Vacant Building for 90 days, with a 90 day waiver (to March 9, 2022) to have its Fire Certificate of Occupancy reinstated or the property will be reclassified to a Category 2 and be subject to those requirements.
