Re: Remove or Repair of the Structure at <u>419 Fry Street</u>

Dear Mr. Johnson:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on December 14, 2021 Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond recommended continuing the above-referenced matter to Legislative Hearing on **Tuesday, January 11, 2022 between 9:00 and 11:00 am via phone.** <u>The following items must be submitted (or completed) by close of business January 7, 2022:</u>

- 1. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation. Staff estimates costs to exceed \$50,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case by case basis;
- 2. note that the second half 2021 taxes due October 15, 2021 have not yet been paid. Those must be brought current before moving forward;
- **3.** submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the **project** and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued; and
- 4. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work. This should include signed subcontractor bids and a <u>schedule</u> for completion of the project; and
- 5. the property must be maintained.

This matter will go before City Council on Wednesday, January 12, 2022 If you will wish to contest to the recommendation Ms. Moermond will give at the January 11, 2022 Legislative Hearing, and testify at the City Council Public Hearing on **December 22, 2021 at 3:30 p.m. in room 300 City Hall**, please contact me at 651-266-8515
