I am writing today to ask you to **VOTE NO** on the proposed ordinance changes to Chapter 324 in St Paul. I work for a Convenience Store Distributor that services your community. There are several reasons that I feel that these changes will hurt the communities of St Paul:

- 1) It should not be the job of the Government to pick winners and losers and that is the result when you have different rules for certain license holders.
- 2) Raising prices will not reduce consumption, it will cause adult consumers to travel out side the city to purchase the items they desire.
- 3) While they travel for Tobacco they will purchase gas, milk, pop, candy and other products causing a reduction in sales tax for you city.
- 4) Convenience stores generate 37% of inside sales from tobacco. The loss of these sales will cause stores to close and employees to be laid off.
- 5) This leads to more abandoned buildings and loss of real-estate taxes for the city.
- 6) This could cause more food deserts in portions of the city that rely on Convenience stores.
- 7) It will add to increased criminal activity through Black Market sales, and those people do not check ID's for underage users.
