Upon arrival we noticed a large broken window on the southwest side of the building. It did not appear that anyone had made entry into the building. We could see the inside of the store through the exterior windows and could see a large glass liquor bottle which was likely used to break the window. The inside of the store appeared to be undisturbed and looked like everything was in place. We contacted DATA to have a board up crew respond to patch the window. The business did have interior cameras but it is unknown at this time if they had captured the suspect or suspects. We photographed the damages and uploaded the photos to the SPPD Media Vault.

ANDREWS told me that he was on vacation for a few days and discovered that his business at the above address had ben broken into by unknown suspects on 09/22/2023. Whereas an initial criminal damage to property report had been completed, ANDREWS was not at the scene at the time to inform officers of any items that had been stolen during the break in.

ANDREWS told me that the suspect(s) had stolen several purses and blanket sets valued at approximately \$2200 USC.
