

On 07/20/2020 at approximately 1938 hours, we, Officers Marquis/Shannon (Squad - 369) were driving past Sana's Market 1541 Maryland Avenue East, while en route to another call for service. We know this business to be a known gang member hangout and narcotics trafficking area. Due to recent high violent crime on the premises the Department of Safety and Inspections placed several sanctions on the license holder holder, one of them being the licensee shall take reasonable steps to discourage loitering in front of or on the property of the license.

As we drove by we saw a large group of black males loitering on the west side of the building. The males were gambling and shooting dice with a large pile of us currency in the middle of them on the ground as the prize for the dice game. The group did this in broad daylight on the store property where the employees could view them by looking out a window with ease. The group also appeared un phased by the Metro Transit Police camera which was approximately 50 feet away and clearly visible.

This appeared to be a clear violation of the licensing stipulations and the employees appeared to be doing nothing to prevent it from occurring.


As we were already on another call for service we were unable to get out and identify the individuals but did create a call for service and activate BWC footage as we drove by.





are operating within the licensing conditions they are mandated to follow by the City of St. Paul and that public safety is regarded while doing so. I began by reviewing all of the included reports and information, as well as any pictures if applicable. The reports on all parties involved were reviewed to determine the course of investigation, as well as the level and probability of solvability. This is all done for information gathering purposes, as well as possible future civil penalties & criminal charges.

Listed below are the current licensing conditions of The One Stop Market:

- 1. License holder will make sure that all refuse and trash that is on the premises and surrounding sidewalks is picked up on a daily basis.
- 2. The licensee shall take reasonable steps to discourage loitering in front of or on the property of the licensed business.
- 3. The license holder shall maintain video surveillance cameras inside and outside the establishment in accordance with the Saint Paul Police Dept. (SPPD) recommendations. The video recordings shall be kept by the license holder for at least thirty (30) days and shall be available for viewing by the Saint Paul Police Department (SPPD) immediately upon request. In addition, if the SPPD responds to a call at the licensed premises, and due to the crime, requests that a copy of the surveillance footage be immediately provided, the license holder shall have technology available to make the copy at the time of the request and shall have it for the police without delay. In other cases, if the SPPD or the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) requests copies of the surveillance tapes, licensee shall have a 48-hour period in which to provide such copies.
- 4. Signage placed on the inside and/or outside of the window shall not take up more than 30% of the window space, and shall not be placed in the area between four (4) and seven (7) feet above the adjacent ground level. Shelving and/ or displays shall not be place in front of the window.

This case has been forwarded to DSI Licensing Manager Eric Hudak and DSI Assistant City Attorney Therese Skarda for review and possible Adverse Action.

On 07.20.2020 Ofc. R. Anderson and I who are currently assigned the gang unit were tasked with sending a CRI (confidential reliable informant) into Sana's Market at 1541 Maryland Avenue east. We had received information that the employees have been selling single cigarettes along with menthol cigarettes.

I pat searched the CRI and made sure they did not have anything on them including money or cigarettes. I then gave them an undisclosed amount of money to purchase single cigarettes from an employee behind the counter.

The CRI was observed by me and assisting officers the entire time until he entered the store. The CRI then

was observed by myself and assisting officers until he was back with me.

The CRI stated that they were able to obtain two single cigarettes from the employee at the store who was working behind the counter.

I took custody of the cigarettes and later placed them into property. The CRI stated the employee took the money from the CRI and placed it in a box behind the counter. The employee then went to the back room and came back and handed the CRI two Newport menthol Cigarettes.

The CRI described the employee that gave them the cigarettes as the youngest male employee in the store was described as tall and thin with longer curly hair with died ends. He also had a white tee shirt on with a design on the front.

It should be noted that this CRI has provided accurate and reliable information over the past ten years to other St. Paul officers
