Re: Remove or Repair of the (accessory) Structure at 1941 University Avenue West

Dear Mr. Solomon, Mr. Asbu, Ms. Ogbaselassie, & Ms. Tekle:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on September 28, 2021 Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond recommended laying the matter over to Legislative Hearing on Tuesday, January 11, 2022 between 9:00 and 11:00 am in room 330 City Hall to review plan development (Please note, at this time these hearings are scheduled to be in person, but that may change due to the Covid-19 pandemic). By close of business Friday, January 7, 2022 please submit:

- 1. a scope of work or architectural plans of proposed use for the space and preliminary contractor bids; and
- 2. the property must be maintained.

As indicated previously, in order to rehabilitate the property, in addition to the above items, the following conditions will need to be met in order to receive a grant of time from the City Council:

- 1. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation. Staff estimates cost to repair exceeding \$50,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case by case basis;
- 2. submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued; and
- 3. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work. This should include signed subcontractor bids and a schedule for completion of the project.

Samples of these documents will be sent at a later date.
