This 48-56 hour course meets the National Fire Protection Association's most current edition NFPA 472 standard for competence of responders to Hazardous Materials/Weapons of Mass Destruction incidents. This course covers such topics as planning a response to a Hazardous Materials incident, container identification, PPE application and Hazardous Materials Management. Additionally, this course is to provide responders who are designed as Hazardous Materials (HAZMAT) Technicians with operations and technician level knowledge, skills and attitudes for critical response requirements for sampling and monitoring chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear or explosive (CBRNE) incidents.

The NFPA divides all of the hazardous material (HAZMAT) related standards into five major categories, tasks, or steps that need to be taken at the scene. The five required tasks are to: Analyze, Plan, Implement, Evaluate and Terminate.

This course explores all five NFPA required HazMat tasks as they relate to the duties of the Hazardous Materials Technician. The primary target audience for this 48 hour course is First Responders charged with the response actions associated with a Hazardous Material release. Students will learn to adapt the knowledge and skill requirements for effective scene and response management. This program is designed to train and educate the student in Hazardous Materials Technician level and in accordance with NFPA 472.
