- 1. Interior Basement MSFC 901.6 The fire alarm system must be maintained in a operative condition at all times, replace or repair where defective. -Have the trouble the alarms on the fire alarm panel cleared by the alarm service company.
- 2. Interior Rear hallway. MSFC 1103.8.1 Replacement of smoke alarms. Single- and multiple station smoke alarms shall be replaced when: They exceed 10 years from the date of manufacture. Smoke alarms shall be replaced with smoke alarms having the same type of power supply. -Have the smoke alarm in the rear hallway replaced.
- 3. Interior Unit B-Living room MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area. -Put a smoke and Carbon Monoxide alarm within 10 feet of the sleeping area off the living room.
- 4. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
