
Legislative Code Chapter 293. - Noise Regulations

- 10 Small speaker system, of speakers on stands, set up on the shoreline, pointing toward the lake, between the docks. We will be playing a music track for a 20min dance performance that will happen on the ice.
- 11 We will ensure the speakers are not pointed toward residential neighborhoods. We will only play the music when we are rehearsing and/or performing, it will not be constant. It is important for the performers to hear the music, and for the audience, which will be on the shore, close to the performance. We do not need anyone outside of the performance area to hear any of the music. It will be very localized to the performance area.
