ASSESSMENT AUTHORIZATION

In order to appeal APPEAL the assessment, you must eit it to the City Council public hearing or present your objection directly to the Council on Wednesday, May 25, 2022 at 3:30 PM. Following the public hearing before the Council, you may appeal your assessment to the district court by serving notice of the appeal upon City Clerk within 30 days after the

adoption of the assessment and filing such notice with the District Court within ten days after service upon the City Clerk.

Quit notices within the times Specified shall forever prohibit an appeal from the assessment.
