Dear Sir/Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on May 19, 2022 and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

1. SPLC 33.07 **FENCES**: No person shall construct, or cause to be constructed, any fence in the City without first obtaining and completing a fence plan review from the building official.

THE CHAIN LINK FENCE ON THE NORTH SIDE OF YOUR PROPERTY HAS BEEN CONSTRUCTED ON THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY. PLEASE REMOVE AND PROPERLY DISPOSE OF ANY PART OF THE CHAIN LINK FENCE THAT IS OUTSIDE OF YOUR PARCEL BOUNDARIES AND ENCROACHES ON THE RIGHT-OF-WAY. ALL STRUCTURES THAT ARE WITHIN THE FENCED AREA AND ON THE RIGHT-OF-WAY MUST BE REMOVED AS WELL, THANK YOU

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on or after July 19, 2022, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges² and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal and pay a filing fee.)

- ² Criminal charges can be brought on the day the violation is observed, but generally we allow time to correct unless this is a repeat violation.

WARNING: Code inspection and enforcement trips cost the taxpayers money. If the violations are not corrected within the time period required in this notice, the city's costs in conducting a reinspection for compliance after the due date will be collected from the owner rather than being paid for by the taxpayers of the City. If additional new violations are discovered within the next following 12 months, the city's costs in conducting additional inspections at this same location within said 12 months will be collected from the owner rather than being paid for by the taxpayers of the City. Any such future costs will be collected via assessment against the real property and are in addition to any other fines or assessments which may be levied against you and your property.
