Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

An attempt was made to inspect your building on July 11, 2022, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. The building is to be vacated by July 30, 2022. An inspection will be made on August 1, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. to verify the property has been vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Interior Basement MSBC Chapter 1300.0120 Permits. Subpart 1. Required. An owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert, or replace any gas, mechanical, electrical, plumbing system, or other equipment, the installation of which is regulated by the code; or cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit.-1. Clothes dryer electrical outlet installation in basement (wiring dated to 8/22/2018).
 - 2. Clothes dryer duct work installation.
 - 3. Sump pump installation in basement (piping dated back to 6/02/2018). A review of the property and building history finds no permit from a licensed contractor for the above-referenced work requiring a permit.

- Interior Second Floor Kitchen NEC 400.10 Provide strain relief for the cords so that tension will not be transmitted to joints or terminals.
 7/11/22 inspection: electrical permit is still open.
- Interior See Comments MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Second Floor Sleeping Room: Outlet is blackened. Electrician to verify this is installed and repaired to work properly. Invoice for electrical work required.
- 4. SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-
- 5. SPLC 40 Revocation is due to long-term non-compliance.7/11/22: permit is not inspected, not met at property.
