




Total City Budget \$781.5M net of transfers

Property Tax Levy Increase Breakout:

Street Maintenance Program 7.74% \$13,572,480

<u>Core Operating Budget</u> 7.6% \$13,328,259

Total 15.34%

- The property tax levy finances a portion of the \$362.5M general fund budget. \$362.5M includes the library agency and is net of transfers.
- Total amount collected from property taxes funds 26% of the total city budget.

2023 Mayor's Proposed Budget Highlights




New Spending in the General Fund
