Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on November 30, 2022, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A re-inspection will be made on December 14, 2022 at 10:30 am. The building needs to be vacated and broom clean and property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (2)(b), 34.33 (1)(d) Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects. *The roof is leaking in multiple areas and there is water on the floor. Have a licensed contractor repair the roof in an approved manner, this work will require a permit.*
- 2. Interior SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.35 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office. Have a licensed contractor make repairs and provide a fuel safety burning test at the time of the inspection. Permits maybe required for the repairs.

- 3. Interior MSFC 315.3 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials. *Reduce* the number of combustibles by 50% and create isle ways through the building.
- 4. Interior SPLC 40.06 The certificate of occupancy is being revoked, for multiple code violations but not limited to: long term non-compliance. All repairs shall be completed before the next inspection, or a date will be given to have the property vacated and broom clean.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
