The City Council will have the final authority to grant or deny the license.

The City Council will have the final authority to grant or deny this license application.

Requirements including the following must be met prior to the issuance of your licenses:

- Submit a completed Personal Affidavit that includes a notarized signature for Lara Scanlan. *The Personal Affidavit submitted does not include a notarized signature.*
- Submit a signed purchase agreement for the purchase of the business and property.
- Submit proof of the source of funds for the purchase of the business.
- Submit a valid Minnesota Tax ID number for Randolph Liquors Inc.
- Contact DSI License Inspector Ross Haddow at 651-266-9143 to schedule the required on-site review of DSI's Liquor License Manual.
