NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE BECAUSE NO WATER SERVICE

RE: 1011 BURNS AVE Ref. # 122901

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 18, 2018.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Master bedroom - SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.34 (3) - Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.-

- 2. Through out house SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17 (5) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the damaged or deteriorated wall coverings. Paint the wall. Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls.
- 3. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 4. SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.34(2) Repair or replace the damaged handrail in an approved manner.-
- 5. SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-
- 6. SPLC 34.11(5), 34.35(2), MPC 408.3 Provide adequate hot water between 120 degrees F and 130 degrees F.-
- 7. SPLC 34.11(4), 34.35(1), MPC 601.1 Provide an adequate water supply to all water closets, sinks, showers and tubs.-

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
