Dear Interested Parties:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on December 13, 2022 Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond recommended continuing the matter to Legislative Hearing on Tuesday, January 24, 2023 at 9 am in room 330 City Hall/Courthouse for further discussion. Property to be broom clean, lockbox installed and ready for Code Compliance Inspection by Wednesday, December 21, 2022.

Once the property is clean, has the doors unscrewed and able to be opened by normal means and a lock box installed, contact Clint Zane at <a href="mailto:clint.zane@ci.stpaul.mn.us">clint.zane@ci.stpaul.mn.us</a> or 651-266-9029 to let him know the lock-box combination.

## For your reference, the following items must be completed before receiving a grant of time from the City Council to rehabilitate the property:

- 1. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation. Staff estimates costs to exceed \$100,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a caseby-case basis;
- 2. submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued; and
- **3. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work.** This should include **signed** subcontractor bids and a **schedule** for completion of the project; and
- 4. the property must be maintained.

Samples of these documents will be sent at a later date; if you would like them earlier please let me know.
