Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on March 2, 2023, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on April 3, 2023 at 1:00 pm or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. North east corner CMU block wall supporting new wall framing and roof SPLC 34.09 (2)(a), 34.33 (1)(a) Provide and maintain foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points.-The CMU block wall that is supporting the new wall and roof framing is leaning in towards the building approximately 3" and has several cracks.
- 2. North east corner Exterior walls SPLC 34.09 (1)(2)(a), 34.33 (1)(b) Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-The walls are exposed OSB.
- 3. North east corner Roof SPLC 34.09 (2)(b), 34.33 (1)(d) Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.-There is no roofing material on the roof covering the stairs to the basement.

4. Open building permit - Inspection required - MSBC Inspections. 1300.0210, Subp. 4. Inspection requests. The building official shall provide the applicant with policies, procedures, and a timeline for requesting inspections. The person doing the work authorized by a permit shall notify the building official that the work is ready for inspection. The person requesting an inspection required by the code shall provide access to and means for inspection of the work. -Have open building permit 21-321429 inspected and approved.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
