NEIGHBORHOOD CAUCUS RECOMMENDATIONS FOR UNIVERSITY OF ST. THOMAS ST. PAUL CAMPUS LIQUOR LICENSE

The Neighborhood Caucus recommends the following conditions be placed on the University of St. Thomas liquor license:

- 1. No Bar. There will be no permanent bar on campus.
- 2. Event registration and management. UST must register all sales events through Facilities Scheduling. UST must supervise these events to ensure that the alcohol stays on the premises where the alcoholic beverages are being sold.
- 3. Event manager training. UST must ensure that event managers take alcohol awareness training with a city-approved vendor.
- 4. Hours of sale. UST is allowed to serve alcoholic beverages from 10 a.m. to midnight.
- 5. Days of sales. UST may sell alcoholic beverages all seven days of the week, including Sunday.
- 6. Annual review. The UST liquor license is subject to annual review both by WSNAC and the City of St. Paul.
- 7. Frequency of Sales. At this time there are no restrictions on the frequency of sales with the understanding that frequency of sales remains within reasonable limits.
- 8. Sale locations. UST may sell alcoholic beverages at the following indoor locations:

Indoor locations (main campus)

- a. Murray-Herrick Campus Center (at least until February 2012)
- b. Anderson Student Center (opens January 2012)
- c. Anderson Athletic and Recreation Complex (but not concession sales at games)
- d. O'Shaughnessy Educational Center foyer
- e. O'Shaughnessy-Frey Library Center
- f. Alumni Center

Indoor locations (south campus)

- g. Binz Refectory (wedding receptions)
- h. Brady Education Center (foyer near auditorium)
- i. Owens Hall first-floor lobby (outside 3M Auditorium)
- j. St. Paul Seminary (foyer or reception area outside board room)

Indoor locations (east-west blocks or east of Cleveland)

- k. McNeely Hall (Great Room facing Cleveland Avenue)
- I. Sitzmann Hall
- m. Morrison House (president's house)
- n. 2120 Summit Avenue (Development house)
- o. 2130 Summit Avenue (faculty emeriti house)

No alcoholic sales may take place in any undergraduate student residences.

Outdoor locations

UST may sell alcoholic beverages at the Homecoming weekend beer tent at either one of the following outdoor locations: Monahan Plaza or the Lower academic quadrangle. No other outdoor alcoholic beverage sales will be permitted.
