The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made after January 3, 2012.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- ENTRANCES MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the exit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.-Remove deadbolt from doors.
- 2. HEAT DETECTORS MSFC 907.20 as amended Provide required annual maintenance of the fire alarm system by a qualified person and provide written documentation to this office as proof of compliance.-Remove heat detector in the basement.
