Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

All Bedrooms - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from 1. each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). finished sill height not the Escape Windows for Residential Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to windows. Openable information.-Double hung Occupancies handout for more height is 19inches.

Sill is 37inches. Glazed is 38inches in height by 26inches in width. Openable width 30 inches.

- 2. Basement MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 3. MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 4. MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.-Remove all cans marked extremely flammable from furnace room
- 5. UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Cannot use duck tape on dryer duct. There is section of the dryer duck that is not code compliant.
- 6. SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private hand sink. Secure bathroom sink to wall
