

2. Basemen SPLC 34.11(5), 34.34(2), SPC 4715.0200Q - Provide adequate hot water between 120 degrees F and 130 degrees F.-Hot water 137 F.

3. Basement - WMC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This

work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Insulate dryer vent 3 feet from outside wall 6042865

4. Basement - MSFC 805.2 - Provide documentation that decorative materials have been treated and maintained with an approved flame retardant or remove decorative materials that do not meet the flame retardant requirements.-Remove plastic from ceiling.

Sherry wood to be 6042666.

North and South bedrooms - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Double hung window openings.

Glazed area.

Height 40 in. - Width 31 in.
