Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on February 22, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on March 22, 2012 at 1:00 P.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

- 1. 929 MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Various locations
- 2. 929 MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-remove all cords fro all pathways
- 3. 929 SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair or replace and maintain the woodwork in an approved manner.-Closet door bottom of stairway

- 4. 929 All bedrooms MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Double hung windows. Openable height is 19inches. Sill is 35inches. Openable width is 39inches. Glazed 38inches in height by 36inches in width.
- 5. 929 Basement MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 6. 929 Basement SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 The basement is condemned as unsafe dangerous when being used for sleeping purposes.. The Basement cannot be must not be used for sleeping purposes until re-inspected and approved by this office.
- 7. 931 MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-Various locations
- 8. 931 MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Various locations
- 9. 931 NEC 110-26 Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.
- 10. 931 NEC 300-11 Provide for all raceways, boxes, cabinets, and fittings to be securely fastened in place.
- 11. 931 MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Stairway leading to basement . Remove all storage shoes and other materials from the basement stairway
- 12. 931 SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Replace all missing door knobs.
- 13. 931 MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.-Remove match light and cans marked extremely flammable from the basement.
- 14. 931 SPLC 200.02 (a) No person shall own, harbor, keep or maintain in the City and dog over three months of age without a license. Provide written documentation of current license to the Fire Inspector. To obtain a dog license, contact DSI at 651-266-8989
- 15. 931 UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 16. 931 MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill

height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Double hung windows. 19inches openable height. Openable width 39inches. Sill 35inches. Glazed is 38inches in height by 36inches in width.

- 17. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 18. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
