Your building was inspected on February 22, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on March 22, 2012 at 11 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

Exterior-Unit 1 - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the door latch.-Repair the rear storm door to close. Adjust the door closure.

2. Exterior-Unit 1 and Unit 2 - SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) - Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.-Provide a handrail for both units in the back of the home to meet code.

3. 266-8686 266-8686 Interior- Unit 2 - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-The windows in Unit 2 do not meet code.

4. Interior- Unit 2 - SPLC \$3.05 - Uncertified portions of the building must not be occupied until inspected and approved by this office.

Interior- Unit 2 - SPLC 34.09 (3) i - Provide and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock.-Provide a dead bolt lock on the door to unit 2.

Interior-Basement - UMC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.

Interior-Basement - MSFC 605.1 - Immediately repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Replace the broken light fixture hanging under the basement steps.

Interior-Basement - MSFC 315.2 - Remove the storage from attic or other concealed spaces or provide and maintain one hour fire resistive construction on the storage side of attics or other concealed spaces. Storage must not be place on exposed joists.-Remove the storage under the basement steps.

Interior-Unit 1 - MN Stat. 299F.362 - Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.-Repair or replace the non working smoke detector in unit 1.

Interior-Unit 1 - MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions. Interior-Unit 1 - NFPA 211, 9-2 - Have the chimneys, fireplaces, and vents inspected for
