Your building was inspected on October 11, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A re-inspection will be made after April 30, 2012.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. BACK EXITS MSFC 1010.1, 1003.2.10 Remove exit signs that do not lead to an approved exit.-Smith street door as an approved exit remove exit sign from south dinning and exit sign by kitchen.
- 2. SMITH STREET MSFC 1010.1, 1003.3.1.2 Exit doors must swing in the direction of travel. Change the swing of the door.-Change door swing. Swing of door shall not sing over public way bring door inward. Contact Fire Inspector for approved locks for exit.
- 3. SMITH STREET MSFC 1010.3 Provide and maintain approved external or internal lighting of the exit sign.-Main entrance is not required to have exit sign.

4. STORE - CEILING - MSFC 805.2 - Provide documentation that decorative materials have been treated and maintained with an approved flame retardant or remove decorative materials that do not meet the flame retardant requirements.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
