Just got your voicemail and here are the exact times for amplified music:

June 7th - concert only 6pm to 9pm

June 14th - concert only 6pm to 9pm

June 21st - concert only 6pm to 9pm

June 28th - concert only 6pm to 9pm

July 5th - NO SHOW

July 12th - concert only 6pm to 9pm

July 19th - concert 6pm to 9pm / movie 9pm to 11pm

July 26th - concert 6pm to 9pm / movie 9pm to 11pm

August 2nd - concert 6pm to 9pm / movie 9pm to 11pm

August 9th - concert 6pm to 9pm / movie 9pm to 11pm

August 16th - concert 6pm to 9pm / movie 9pm to 11pm

August 23rd - concert 6pm to 9pm / movie 9pm to 11pm

August 30th - concert 6pm to 9pm / movie 9pm to 11pm

I think we usually have a 80 or 90 db level for the concerts and while we do you the sound stage for the movie audio, we generally run that just loud enough for the people at the park to hear it. This may even run very close to the park's after 10pm db level. We didn't run movies last year but the year prior some people showed up at the city council meeting thinking that I was programing music until 11pm. It wasn't a issue when they realized it was the movie running after 9pm. Hope this clears it up and let me know if you have any additional questions for me.
