- 1. Garage SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects. This work will require a permit. Contact DSI at 651-266-8989.
- 2. Interior SPLC 34.12 (2), 34.35 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition.-Replace the battery in the smoke detector that has a low battery.
- 3. Interior SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-Provide access for reinspection on May 16 2012 at 9:30 AM
- 4. Unit 1 SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-Replace the missing door knob and latch.
