Exterior MSFC 307.1 All fires on the ground must be a minimum of 25 feet from structures and property line or contained in an approved container grill or outdoor fireplace and 15 feet from structures and property line. Wind speeds must be under 10 mph, constantly attended, a means of extinguishments must be provided. Only natural firewood can be burned (no construction materials, brush or waste materials), and fire shall be extinguished if the smoke is deemed a nuisance. A citation will be issued for non-compliance.-Remove the fire pit and fire debris in the back yard.-Remove the fire pit and any fire debris.

- 5. Throughout MSFC 605.5.3 Immediately, discontinue use of frayed, deteriorated, damaged or spliced electrical cords.-MSFC 605.5.3 Immediately, discontinue use of frayed, deteriorated, damaged or spliced electrical cords. Remove the temporary Decorative lights throughout the building.
- 6. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 7. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 8. SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.
