Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on September 13, 2012. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on or after October 15, 2012.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Unit 4 SPLC 62.101 Use of this property does not conform to zoning ordinance. Discontinue unapproved use or call DSI Zoning at (651) 266-8989 to convert to legal use. Discontinue: There is a fourth 4 unit on the westside of building contact Zoning for this unit to be legal.-The owner has to have another parking space because the building according to Zoning is a tr3 and you can only have three parking spaces in the front of building. One parking space has to be in the rear. Owner states he will appeal because it is a hardship to install a parking space in the rear of the building.
- 2. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 3. MN Rules 1300.0180 Immediately discontinue use of unsafe heating appliance until repaired or replaced by a licensed contractor. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Red tags may not be removed except by fire department inspector.-Your contractor has red tagged your heating system. Meaning your system cannot be used. The heating unit is to be installed 9-14-12 JT
