Dear Property Representative:

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

The third floor of building (Unit 4) must be vacated by September 30, 2012 unless all work is approved under permit by this date. A re-inspection will be made on October 1, 2012 at 1:00 pm.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Unit 4 - MSFC 1005.2 - Provide an approved additional means of egress due to an inadequate number of approved exits. - This 3rd floor unit requires two exits. Second exit is a stairway which goes to the 1st floor roof and then ends with no landing, no guardrail and no means to further travel to grade level. This work will require a building permit. Contact DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 2. Unit 4 - SPLC 34.19 - Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-Provide access to unit on October 1, 2012 at 1:00 pm. Unit must be vacated or building in full compliance.
