- 2. MSFC 605.6 - Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.-
- 3. SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.33 (5) - Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination.-
- 4. SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) - Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner. The floor covering has nails that are purtruding up from the floor. Provide threshold borders for the thresholds-Repair or replace the floor coverings.
