Re: Remove or Repair of the Structure at 1033 Galtier Street

Dear Mr. Flyckt & Mr. Soczynski:

This is to confirm that on September 8, 2020, Marcia Moermond, Legislative Hearing Officer will recommend at **the September 23, 2020 3:30 p.m. City Council meeting** that they refer the matter back to **Legislative Hearing on October 13, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.** for further discussion. **Due to the pandemic, this hearing will take place via phone between 9 and 10 a.m.**

As discussed previously, should the owner wish to rehabilitate the property, the following conditions will have to be met:

- 1. submit evidence of financial documentation for the cost (\$100,000) to rehab the project, noting that proof of funds will need to be demonstrated before getting approval for grant of time;
- 2. apply for a Code Compliance inspection with the Department of Safety & Inspections (DSI);
- 3. submit an affidavit dedicating the funds for the rehab;
- 4. post a \$5,000 performance deposit with the Department of Safety & Inspections (DSI);
- 5. submit preliminary work plan and bids; and
- 6. the property must be maintained.

A new City Council public hearing will be scheduled for November 4, 2020 at 3:30 p.m. A new hearing notice will be sent.
