If you have sent in an objection, you will receive notice of the time, place and date of the scheduled hearing. At that hearing, the Legislative Hearing Officer will take testimony from all interested persons. At the end of this hearing, the Legislative Hearing Officer will make a recommendation to the City Council as to whether the license request should be approved or be referred to an administrative law judge for further review. The City Council will have the final authority to grant or deny the license.

Dear Applicant:

Our review of your application for a license to *serve alcohol indoors* is in process. Notification has been sent to the community organization and neighbors for the area in which you intend to operate giving them until **Friday, July 16, 2021** to voice concerns to your application. Enclosed find an affidavit listing conditions DSI recommends be placed on this license. If you accept these conditions, please sign and return the affidavit. If you want to oppose placement of any of the conditions on the license, or have any questions, please contact DSI at one of the numbers referenced below so that we may explain your options.

If no objections are received, and you have returned a signed affidavit, your license will be forwarded to the City Council for review and if approved by Council could then be_issued (pending any requirements not completely met). If objections are received a hearing will be scheduled before a legislative hearing officer. You will receive notice of the time, place and date of the scheduled hearing from the Legislative Hearing Officer. At that hearing, the hearing officer will take testimony from all interested persons and will make a recommendation to the City Council as to whether the license(s) should be approved or be referred to an administrative law judge for further review. The City Council will have the final authority to grant or deny this license application.

Requirements including the following must be met prior to the issuance of your licenses:

- Obtain DSI Zoning Division approval. You may contact DSI Zoning Inspector Farhan Omar at 651-266-9089 or via email at <u>Farhan.Omar@ci.stpaul.mn.us</u> to arrange for this approval.
- Obtain all necessary building and/or trade permits related to any construction work associated with the establishment of this use, and all required inspection approval(s) related to these permit(s). Only licensed trade contractors authorized to perform work in that trade (e.g., plumbing, electrical, ventilation, etc.) may obtain permit(s) and/or perform work in such trade.
- Obtain a Sewer Availability Charge (SAC) determination from the Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES). Information about the SAC program may be found at the following website http://www.metrocouncil.org/Wastewater-Water/Funding-Finance/Rates-Charges/Sewer-Availability-Charge.aspx Payment of any SAC fee owed would be submitted to DSI.
- Submit a signed statement listing all owners (including percentage of ownership for each individual) of the busines entity Hogan-Bard LLC.
- Submit signed Personal Affidavit forms (see enclosed copy) which *include a notarized signature* for each owner of the business.
- Submit a completed State of Minnesota Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement Division (AGED) Certification of an On Sale Liquor License application form (see enclosed copy).
- Sign and return one copy of the enclosed license condition affidavit acknowledging the conditions that will be placed on your license(s). A return envelope has been included for your convenience.

Finally, this review is only for **indoor** alcohol service, and does not include your application for the Liquor Outdoor Service Area (Sidewalk) license. A separate review process (i.e., public notice, City Council review, etc.) will be required for this additional license. A petition of support must be included with any application to extend alcohol service to the outdoors. Enclosed please find information explaining the petition of support requirements & a list of property owners you must attempt to get supportive signatures from. Please inform DSI if you will be working to satisfy the petition of support requirements or decide to withdraw your Liquor Outdoor Service Area (Sidewalk) license application. Once you have submitted a sufficient petition of support DSI can begin the review process for the Liquor Outdoor Service Area (Sidewalk) license.
