Your building was inspected on September 16, 2021 for the renewal of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy and was approved. When the required fee has been paid you will receive your certificate. There are however seasonal or non-life safety deficiencies noted below which must be corrected prior to re-inspection.

The following deficiencies must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on October 18, 2021 at 1:00 p.m.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- Fire Alarm MSFC 907.8 Provide required annual maintenance of the fire alarm 1. system by a qualified person and provide written documentation to this office as proof of compliance. - Annual testing is required if the monitored fire alarm system is maintained. The fire alarm devices connected to the security panel are part of a partial, non-required alarm system and may alternately be removed.
- Fire Keybox MSFC 506.2 Install a fire department keybox near the main entry at 7 2. feet high. Keybox can be ordered from Knox Company at 1-800-552-5669 or knoxbox.com. - A fire keybox is required if the monitored fire alarm system is maintained. The fire alarm devices connected to the security panel are part of a partial, non-required alarm system and may alternately be removed.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer. Applications for appeals may be obtained at the Office of the City Clerk, 310 City Hall, City/County Courthouse, 15 W Kellogg Blvd, Saint Paul MN 55102 Phone: (651-266-8585) and must be filed within 10 days of the date of this order.
