The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on September 24, 2021 and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

- 1.SPLC 34.15 **SMOKE DETECTOR:** The occupant of a dwelling unit must inform the owner of the dwelling unit of a nonfunctioning smoke detector within 24 hours of discovering that the smoke detector in the dwelling unit is not functioning. Smoke detector may not be tampered with or disabled at any time.
- 2...SPLC 33.03 PLUMBING: Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition. Permits may be required. REPAIR/REPLACE LEAKING TOILET
- 3.SPLC 34.10 CABINETS: All cabinets must be maintained in a sound condition and in a professional state of maintenance and repair. KITHCHEN AND BATHROOM
- 4.SPLC 34.09 DOOR(S): All doors and its hardware shall be in sound condition and fit within its frame. Doors shall be maintained in a professional state of maintenance and repair. Repair or replace the damaged door, hardware, or frame. LARGE HOLE IN BEDROOM DOOR
- 5.SPLC 33.03 (c) DRYER VENTING: Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 6.SPLC 45.03 GAS SHUT OFF VALVE: Provide an approved gas shut off valve within 6 feet of the appliance in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. FOR DRYER CAP OFF AND INSTALL SHUT OFF.

7.SPLC 34.10 **CEILINGS:** All ceilings must be maintained in a sound condition and in a professional state of maintenance and repair. BATHROOM

8.SPLC 45.03 **EXTENSION CORDS:** Immediately, discontinue use of frayed, deteriorated, damaged or spliced electrical cords adequate to meet the building's needs. This work may require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-9090. THROUGHOUT BASEMENT

9.SPLC 34.10 **FLOORS:** All floors must be maintained in a sound condition and in a professional state of maintenance and repair. KITHCHEN AND BATHROOM

10.SPLC 45.03 **INTERIOR SANITATION:** The interior shall be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition, free from any accumulation of refuse or garbage. DINING ROOM AND BASEMENT.

11.SPLC 34.13 **SLEEPING ROOMS:** Sleeping room does not meet light, ventilation or escape requirements. Stop this use of this room or repair to meet sleeping room requirements. BASEMENT

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on or after

ITEMS 1 THROUGH 6 by September 29, 2021, and ITEMS 7 THROUGH 11 by October, 15,2021

by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges² and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal and pay a filing fee.)

- ² Criminal charges can be brought on the day the violation is observed, but generally we allow time to correct unless this is a repeat violation.
