## Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

30 ACKER ST W Ref. # 121064

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on September 30, 2021, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on November 1, 2021 at 2:30 p.m. or the property vacated by November 15, 2021..

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

## DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Living room and back bedroom SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17 (5) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner. All interior walls, floors, ceiling, woodwork and cabinets must be maintained in a found condition and in a professional state of maintenance and repair. Whenever the words "professional state of maintenance and repair" are used in this chapter, they shall mean that such maintenance and repair shall be complete and made in a reasonable and skillful manner. For example, generally plumb, level, square, sound, in line, undamaged and without marring adjacent work.
- 2. SPLC 40.06 Revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy is due to long-term non-compliance.-

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
