Amending the financing and spending plans in the Department of Emergency Management for the 2021 Urban Area Security Initiative Grant for \$829,500.

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul has applied for and received a grant of \$829,500 from the State of Minnesota for the 2021 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant to purchase EOC equipment, cyber security equipment, soft and hard target equipment, emerging threats training and equipment, and provide staffing for the Department of Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, the financing and spending plans have not been established for the grant received; and
