- 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA at 50 feet from all sound sources
- 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who shall provide continuous sound level monitoring at each sound mix during the hours of the variance.
- 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 9:00 p.m. on May 27 and 28, 2023, the event dates.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on the May 27 and 28, 2022 dates may result in denial of future requests for the grant of a noise variance, in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

Thai Cultural Council of Minnesota, represented by Project Coordinator, Farah Meenakanit, has requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to present amplified sound, with limitations, from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on May 27 and 28, 2023 with a pre-event sound check at 8:00 a.m. on May 27 and 28, 2023. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
