- 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured at 50 feet from all sound sources.
- 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who shall provide continuous sound level monitoring at each sound mix during the hours of the variance.
- 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 6:00 p.m. October 29, 2022, the event date.
- 5) The variance is granted contingent upon the applicant gaining permission to use the space in which the event will take place.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on the October 29, 2022 date may result in denial of future requests for the grant of a noise variance, in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.
