Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): Property owner stated that they had to wait to pay the Quarter 1 2021 invoice because the initial invoice was incorrect due to them being billed incorrectly for a bulky item. Property owner stated that they made a payment of \$66.05 on 02/17/2021 based on the amount that they were given by the customer service representative.

Staff Comments: Hauler records confirm that the initial invoice did include an incorrect bulky item charge. They requested that the late fee assessment be removed. Therefore staff recommends removing the assessment.
