



- 1) To respond to the public health emergency or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or aid to impacted industries such as tourism, travel, and hospitality;
- 2) To respond to workers performing essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency by providing premium pay to eligible workers;
- 3) For the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue due to the COVID-19 public health emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year prior to the emergency; and
- 4) To make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate its response to the negative economic impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency, the City identified the following area of need that meets the ARPA eligibility criteria, for a total of \$4,500,000:

- 1) PED Tourism Package: \$4,500,000

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.07.4 of the City Charter, the Mayor recommends the transfer of unencumbered ARPA appropriations between departments and, as outlined in the attached financial analysis, which is consistent with the City's plan to shift ARPA funds to project-specific accounts for spending; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of Saint Paul does hereby authorize the City to transfer \$4,500,000 from the ARPA holding account to a project-specific account as outlined in the attached financial analysis.
