WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report

of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Property Clean Up services during December 14 to 31, 2020. (~~File No. J2114A, Assessment No. 218513~~ File No. J2114A1, Assessment No. 218541) and the assessment roll including all properties for which these assessments are proposed for Council ratification; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has reviewed an appeal of this assessment and developed a recommendation for the City Council with respect to this assessment; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing having been conducted for the above improvement, and said assessment having been further considered by the Council and having been considered financially satisfactory; Now, Therefore, Be It
