WHEREAS, the Fire Department would like to apply for the 2021 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness (HMEP) grant to provide training for firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the total grant amount is \$31,500 and the State of Minnesota portion for the training would be \$25,200; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a 25% in-kind match of \$6,300 which would be met with the salaries of the firefighters attending the training; now, therefore, be it
