WHEREAS, Saint Paul Legislative Code Section 61.203 states that the Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA) consists of nine (9) members (seven (7) regular members and two (2) alternate members) appointed by the mayor with the consent of the council; and

WHEREAS The Board of Zoning Appeals holds public hearings on administrative appeals and for minor and major zoning variances, and

WHEREAS, Jerome Benner applied to serve on the Board of Zoning Appeals; and

WHEREAS Mayor Carter wishes to appoint Jerome Benner to the Board of Zoning Appeals for a term ending on January 31, 2026, now, therefore be it
