WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 22-1587 accepted the Report of Completion for Collection of Vacant Building Registration Fees billed during the time period of January 7 to July 21, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has considered objections of affected property owners and developed recommendations for the City Council with respect to their assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on February 8, 2023 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and
